- II. Lean Not on Your Own Understanding.**
 - a. 1Cor 3:18-20- Worldly wisdom is lacking.
 - b. Colossians 2:8- Worldly wisdom is destructive.
- III. In All your Ways Acknowledge Him (Live by the Spirit)**
 - a. Galatians 5- Fruit of the Flesh v.s. Fruit of the Spirit.
 - b. Acknowledge God
